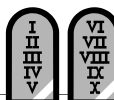

Easter Duty: Canon 920 specifies that the Easter Duty (Catholic's obligation of receiving Holy Communion during the Easter Season) be made from the First Sunday of Lent (March 1st) to Trinity Sunday (June 7th). The Canon adds that "for a good reason" it can be fulfilled at another time during the year. Canon 989 requires that Catholics receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation once a year.

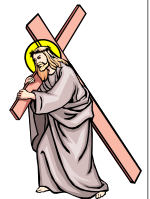
