A physician's authorization and a signed parent permit is required in order for school personnel to administer medication to a student. Medication can legally be given only **with** a physician's written order. Medication must be brought to school in the prescription container, properly labeled, including: child's name, physician's name and directions for administering.

Please consult your physician on the timing of medication as some prescriptions can be written to eliminate the need for giving medication during school hours.

Over the counter medications will be given with a written order from a physician and the parent's signed directive.
