The drill will consist of us “acting” as though we have an intruder in the building. The teachers will turn out the lights and make sure the doors are locked while the students go out of sight. In the younger grades, they usually “play a game” of being super quiet while the teacher reads quietly as possible to the class. Kids can internalize things and I want you to be prepared if they ask questions at home. It’s always important to remember that God will protect us if we do our part.
