

The Knights of Columbus are hosting a **Lenten Fish Fry each Friday during Lent** from 4:30 to 7:30 pm in the Parish Hall.

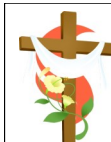
