Our **Charity and Stewardship Appeal** begins this weekend with the theme of “*Cast your Net*” (John 21:6). The goal for NAM is \$94,100. The assessment of the goal from our parish to support diocesan programs is \$18,820 or 20% of the goal. Anything raised over the goal, NAM receives 100% back. The projected rebate for NAM is \$75,280.

Last year we had 409 people make a pledge to the campaign for a total of \$120,426.68. North American Martyrs has received back \$85,189.68 so far. We have an anticipated refund total of \$101,364.68.

Calvary Cemetery, our Lincoln Catholic cemetery, has asked for our help in preparing the grounds before Memorial Day on **Wednesday, May 22nd**, 5:30 pm until dark.
