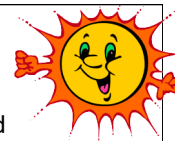

My name is **Jim Beran** and I was born and raised right here in Lincoln. I'm from Cathedral parish and was very blessed to have my parents send me to Catholic school from kindergarten through high school. After graduating from Pius in 2006 I enlisted in the Marine Corps. I served 4 years in the Marines deploying twice, including once to Afghanistan. I then attended UNL for 3 years, where I felt God calling me to the seminary.
