MOVIE NIGHTS

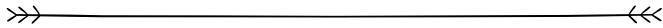
WHEN: MONDAY JULY 1, 7:00-9:30PM

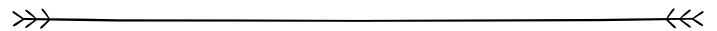
