
Last Year's Finances




• \$112,254.77 shortfall

- Income from stewardship and fundraising did not meet expectations
- Higher payroll expenses and Diocesan assessments
- The NAM budget has been balanced (or surplus) over the past 10 years



- However, Sunday Collection (main income source) has been flat since 2015


Total NAM 10 Year Giving History



Expense Breakdown



- Payroll (largest expense by far) has shown modest increases
- Pius X and Diocesan Assessments have doubled and tripled over 10 years!
- Property and Utility expenses have been flat, even with building addition



The Good News



- We have had a balanced budget over previous 10 years
- Building campaign (OFOFOF) was a huge success providing much needed space for the parish and school
- Education quality at NAM School is exceptional:
 - Excellent teacher and family support
 - The Iowa Basic Test Scores show out elementary students continue to improve each year and by the time they complete 8th grade, they are performing way above average
 - At 2019 Pius X graduation, 16 of our former 45 NAM graduates received Regents scholarships to UNL
- Our cost of education is <\$4000/student, far below \$11,274/student at LPS.





- Losing \$150,000/year benefactor
- Losing a portion of technology fund this year, and more next year
- Parking lot and boiler repair expenditures
- Need to find ways to make up the difference

- Potential Solutions
 - 1. Cut Expenses
 - 2. Increase Income Faithful Steward Scholarship Pledges
 - 3. Increase Income Convert some of OFOFOF giving to Sunday Offertory
 - 4. Increase Income Annual Stewardship Renewal for entire parish
 - 5. Increase Income Raise Tuition
 - 6. Increase Income Evangelization and education to those currently giving <\$500
 - 7. Increase Income Hire Financial Development Director
 - 8. Tracking Change how Finance Committee is tracking parish finances


Potential Solution 1:

Cut Expenses

- Payroll is dominate expense (at 72%)
- Eliminated Evangelization Position
- Cost/child for education is already very low (<\$4000/student)
- Teacher base pay is only 73% of LPS
- Classroom sizes are already very large

<u>Potential Impact:</u> Reduced Expenses by **\$23K**

Increase Income – Faithful Steward Scholarship Pledges

Faithful Stewardship Scholarship

- Cost of education is about \$3,500/student
- Scholarship is currently up to \$2,650/student
- Resulting tuition for families is \$850/student

Annual Evaluation

- Mass Attendance = 40%
- Time Pledge = 20%
- Talent Pledge = 20%
- Treasure Pledge 20%

Potential Impact: Increase giving by \$113K

Potential Solution 3:

Increase Income – Convert some of OFOFOF giving to Sunday Offertory

- Building Campaign (OFOFOF) ends this year (now through July 2020)
- Can we encourage parishioners to convert some portion or all of their pledge into ongoing tithing?

Potential Impact in 2019-2020:


- At 30% conversion, \$75K could be raised this year
- At 50% conversion, \$124K could be raised this year

Potential Impact in 2020-2021 (after all pledges retire):

- At 30% conversion, \$229K could be raised
- At 50% conversion, \$382K could be raised

Pledges


- Pledge to date: \$4,525,049
- Cash received to date: \$3,865,844
- Families contributing: 722
- 458 Pledges are scheduled to be paid off in 2020 with most in April and May

Project cost:

- Original Bid: \$2,927,600
- Change Orders: \$216,268
- Architect/Testing/Other: \$255,815
- Total Project Cost: \$3,399,683

Outstanding Debts

- Contractor: \$20,000 retainer
- Joy of the Gospel: \$310,000
- DI&L Loan: \$516,909




Potential Solution 4:

Increase Income – Annual Stewardship Renewal for entire parish

- Stewardship Committee was already considering this idea
- Possibly Fall 2019
- All parishioners
- Encourage working towards tithing goal to NAM of 5% of gross income

Potential Impact: If all parishioners increased their Sunday giving by 10%, this would be \$127K





For a household income of \$50,000, a 5% tithe to the Parish would be \$2,500.

Potential Solution 5:


Increase Income – Raise Tuition

- Goal is to keep Catholic education affordable and accessible to all parishioners
- Tuition would be the amount after applying for a Faithful Steward Scholarship for K-8
- Include evaluation of pre-school fees and tuition paid by students outside of the parish

Potential Impact in 2019-2020:

- Tuition is set for 2019-2020, so no impact this year
 Potential Impact in 2020-2021:
- Needs to be analyzed, including comparison to other parishes
 - For reference, a 10% increase in K-8 tuition, out of parish tuition, and Pre-school fees would increase income \$60K






Potential Solution 6:

Increase Income – Evangelization and Education to those currently giving < \$500/year

MAR YRS

- Starts with evangelization
- Need many volunteers to organize personal outreach to invite and engage
- Last year approximately 900 families gave <\$500
 - 574 families give \$0
 - 328 families gave \$1 to \$500
- This would take time to organize, so likely only small increase in 2019-2020.
- This is a long-term solution

Potential Impact: If half of these families (450) increased their giving by \$20/month (\$240/year), this would be about **\$108K**.



Potential Solution 7:

Increase Income – Hire Financial Development Director



- Position would lead activities focused on financial giving
- Hard to hire position when operating in the red
- This is a long-term solution

Potential Impact: Initial additional cost for position. Potential impact for increasing income could be significant in the long-term

Potential Responsibilities:

- Plan, manage, and implement annual giving activities
- Coordinate volunteer efforts
- Pursue major gifts through estates and wills
- Research, identify, and write grants for external funding
- Pursue endowment funding
- Pursue opportunities for employer matching funds

Potential Solution 8:

Tracking – Change how Finance Committee is tracking parish finances

- Developing key indicators to track
- Develop anticipated annual patterns for key indicators
- Quarterly meetings to review actual versus anticipated
- Include balance sheet in review
- Develop regular approach to communicate results with parish

<u>Potential Impact:</u> Early warning if finances are not tracking as planned

Conversion of OFOFOF Pledges




- Can we encourage parishioners to convert some portion of their pledge into ongoing tithing?


