Our **Charity and Stewardship Appeal** has begun with the theme of “Go To Joseph”. The goal for NAM is \$98,510. The projected rebate for NAM is \$78,808 or 80% of Goal. The assessment from our parish to support diocesan programs is \$19,702 or 20% of the goal. Anything raised over the goal, NAM receives 100% back. In this year of the St. Joseph, we have engaged with architect Kevin Clark to draw plans to renovate our Adoration Chapel. Anything raised over our goal will go towards that project.

Last year we had people make a pledge to the campaign for a total of \$87,259. North American Martyrs has received back \$62,033.50 so far. We have an anticipated refund total of \$68,719.
