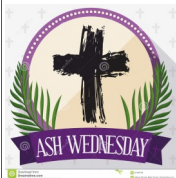

## Lenten News



The Season of **Lent** begins this week on **Ash Wednesday, March 2nd**. Mass Times will be at 6:40 am, 8:00 am, 5:15 pm and 6:30 pm.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence from meat for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. For members of the Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

NAM welcomes everyone to the **Stations of the Cross** to meditate on the passion, death, and resurrection of our Lord Fridays during Lent at 6:00 p.m. and on Good Friday at 3:00 p.m.

Join our parish for a **Lenten Book Study**, "I Thirst, 40 days with Mother Teresa", similar to our Advent study. We hope that Mother Teresa's love of Jesus can inspire a deeper love of Him within ourselves this next 6 weeks. Our hope is that this study would be done with couples, families, siblings, men's groups, women's groups, couples groups or maybe just yourself.
