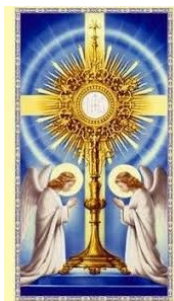

Happy Easter to our NAM Parishioners.

We certainly wish you a very Happy Easter Octave and upcoming 50 day Season. Having just concluded the 40 Days of Lenten prayer, fasting and almsgiving, the Holy Triduum of Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Vigil and Sunday, we now enter into a whole new Season. As St. Paul said, "If Christ had not risen, our faith is in vain." The Resurrection gives strength, inspiration and hope to everything we do in life. The life of Christ is always seen as a whole Paschal Mystery including His life, example, teachings and passion, death and resurrection.
