A NOTE FROM OUR ASSISTANT PASTOR:

Dear North American Martyrs Family,

What does it mean when the Clergy Assignments say, "Rev. Joseph Wahlmeier is temporarily relieved of his pastoral obligations in the Diocese of Lincoln to study for a Licentiate in Theology, specializing in Biblical Theology, at the Pontifical Gregorian University, in Rome Italy"? First of all, it means our time together is drawing to an end. On June 19th, I will depart North American Martyrs. It means I will move into the seminary in Seward in order to spend the summer helping around the diocese as well as visiting family and friends before I leave for Rome. It means that sometime in August I will depart for Rome, spending a few weeks first to catch up on language (yes, my classes will have to be in Italian!). It means I will spend a couple years there to finish my degree, with the ability to come home for summers and Christmases in between. This degree means that I may have opportunities to teach on Scripture and Biblical Languages in service of the Church, or at least have a lifetime of homily material! It also means my mom and dad will miss me (but not too much, because ironically, I call home a lot more often when I'm far away than when I'm right down the interstate). It does mean I will miss all of you, especially the wonderful ways we give Christ to each other in living the sacramental life and witnessing the Gospel of Christ here at Martyrs.
