

A NOTE FROM OUR PASTOR:

Dear North American Martyrs Family,

In John 17 we have what's called the High Priestly Prayer of Jesus. Jesus prays for Himself, for all His disciples, and then specifically for His priests. Christ's example is that we pray for the priests of our



Church. This Saturday (5/27/2023), our diocese ordains three new priests, and our parish will host the FIRST MASS of soon to be Fr. Matthew Schilmoeller, a son of this parish.

The beginning of priesthood is critical. They need to learn to have the heart of a priest. Giving. Loving. Continuing to Pray and Study. Pouring themselves out to give Jesus to people at any point and time of their lives, be it in the midst of tragedy or joy. BUT, it is kind of easy to pray for new priests. It's exciting. But we are all called to pray for every priest. This isn't a self-serving request ... well, maybe a little. But it is following the example of Christ to Pray for priests, because they have a two-part call. First, priests need to be a conduit to connect people with Jesus. Second, they need to work out their own salvation.

With that first part, yes, there are examples where instead of a priest being a conduit for Christ ... they are an obstacle. Like any human, when a priest is wounded or desires something other than Jesus, they cause damage on so many levels. I feel very sad when someone said they left the Church because of a priest. So my encouragement is actually to talk about the first 12 priests, the apostles. What happened with them? One of 12 completely betrayed Jesus (that Judas). Then when things got tough and Jesus was being led to the cross, another 10 ran and hid. In the end, only 1 of the 12 was faithful to the point of being at the foot of the cross ... St. John. In short, Jesus knew the weaknesses of the apostles and still chose them. He did this to let us know that your salvation or mine should never be dependent upon the personality or weaknesses of priests. You don't leave Jesus because of a Judas. You don't leave the Truth because one priest wasn't living the Truth. But this is why Christ prayed for His priests. Their lives are meant to point to the true Savior, but just like any other human they can fall short.

Again, I'm not excusing anything, I actually need to work out how hard I am on priests. We are human with our plusses and minuses. My plusses reach some and my minuses turn away others. In addition, as a priest we need OTHER priests. To guide, support, and hear our confessions. I made Msgr. Tucker my confessor. He was my pastor in Morse Bluff when I was in 3rd and 4th grade, he heard my confessions then, and he hears them now. So, I pray and try to support and serve my fellow priests. I told Fr. Wahlmeier and Fr. Asitha that I want to serve their priesthood. Is our Lord calling you to help in that area too?


