

A Note from our Assistant Pastor...

Hello everyone,

While growing up outside of David City, in the Bohemian Alps, I discovered a love for the night sky. I remember there being this one star that goes by the name of Deneb. This star is the farthest one that we can see with the naked eye. Scientists claim it's about 2,600 light years away which is equivalent to 19



quadrillion miles. So when you are looking at any star in the night sky, you are looking into the past, because the light you see on a darkened night was emitted thousands of years ago, but it is just now arriving to earth.

If that's not mind-blowing enough, astronomers have also been able to measure the starlight in the night sky, and they have estimated that there are 100 billion stars in our galaxy alone. Then, using our own galaxy as a model, they were able to take those 100 billion stars and multiply it by the number of galaxies in the universe (2 trillion), which means that the number of stars in the entire universe is probably around 200 sextillion.

So where I am going with all of this? Well, our Psalm for this weekend is encouraging us to praise the Lord, not only because of what He has done for His people, but for what He continues to do. Our Psalmist even mentioned that God tells the number of the stars; He calls each by name. We have a God who has perfect knowledge of every star in the Heavens, but to our surprise - that is not the focus of this stanza. The Psalmist wants you to know that this mighty God also has a deep and intimate concern for you. Who could have guessed that the Lord who created the stars would desire to stoop down to our level, just so He can heal the brokenhearted and hold up the lowly!? In His eyes, you are much brighter than the most radiant suns and more precious than the jewels of the night sky. So the next time you find yourself looking at the stars, remember who you are and to whom you belong. Remember all the good things God has done for you and know that you are loved.


