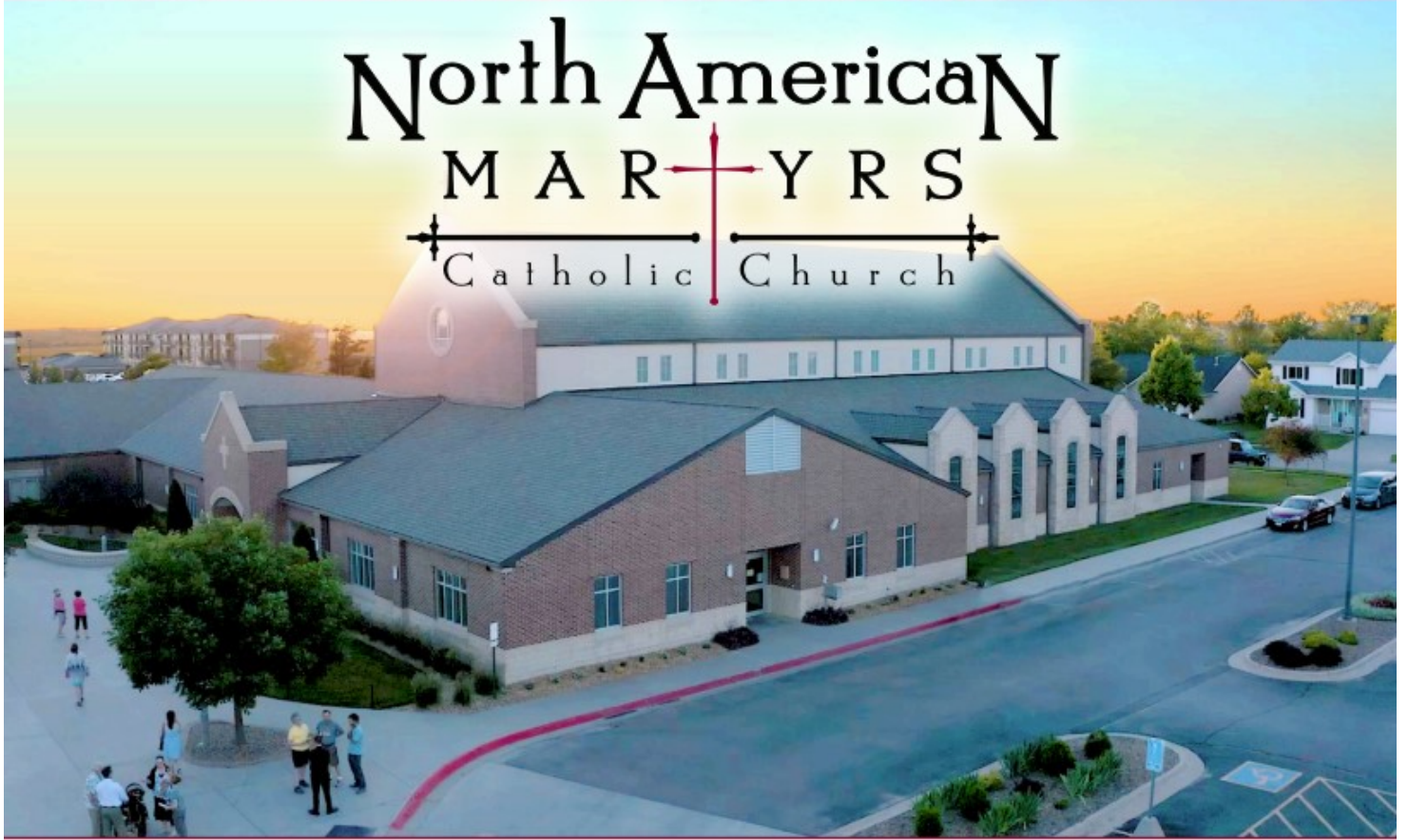

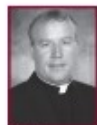

## A Note from our Pastor...



This is the First Sunday of Lent. I had given this suggestion last year, but I think it can be so helpful as far as personal practices go.

1. Remove something weighing you down. Do you want to work on freeing yourself from things you feel you're dependent upon? Then giving up something for Lent is perfect!

2. Add something positive. Lent is also the time to make deeper spiritual connections in your life. Adding positive activities like increasing silent prayer time will help you process life and receive love, encouragement, and guidance from God who loves you so much.

3. My advice is to start small with goals you can achieve and ramp it up each week.

4. Let's do an example:

a. I spent too much time just scrolling on my phone.

i. Week 1: I only use my phone for calls/texts on Monday and Friday.

ii. Week 2: Now it's Monday, Wednesday, Friday.

iii. Week 3: Now it's during the week.

Iv. Week 4: Including Saturday now.

v. Keep going till Easter!

B. I want to add more time for prayer/silence reflection.

i. Week 1: I'll add 30 minutes of quiet time to be with God on Mondays, Fridays, and Sundays. Either sitting in a room at home, going for a walk, or visiting a Church. *Set your phone alarm and then set it aside till it rings.*

ii. Week 2: Now it's Monday, Wednesday, Friday, and Sunday.

iii. Week 3: Now each day of the week.

iv. Keep going till Easter!

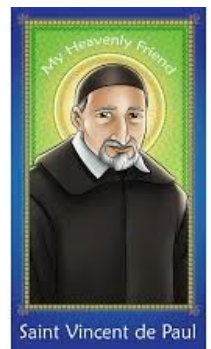
### UNBOUND MINISTRY
