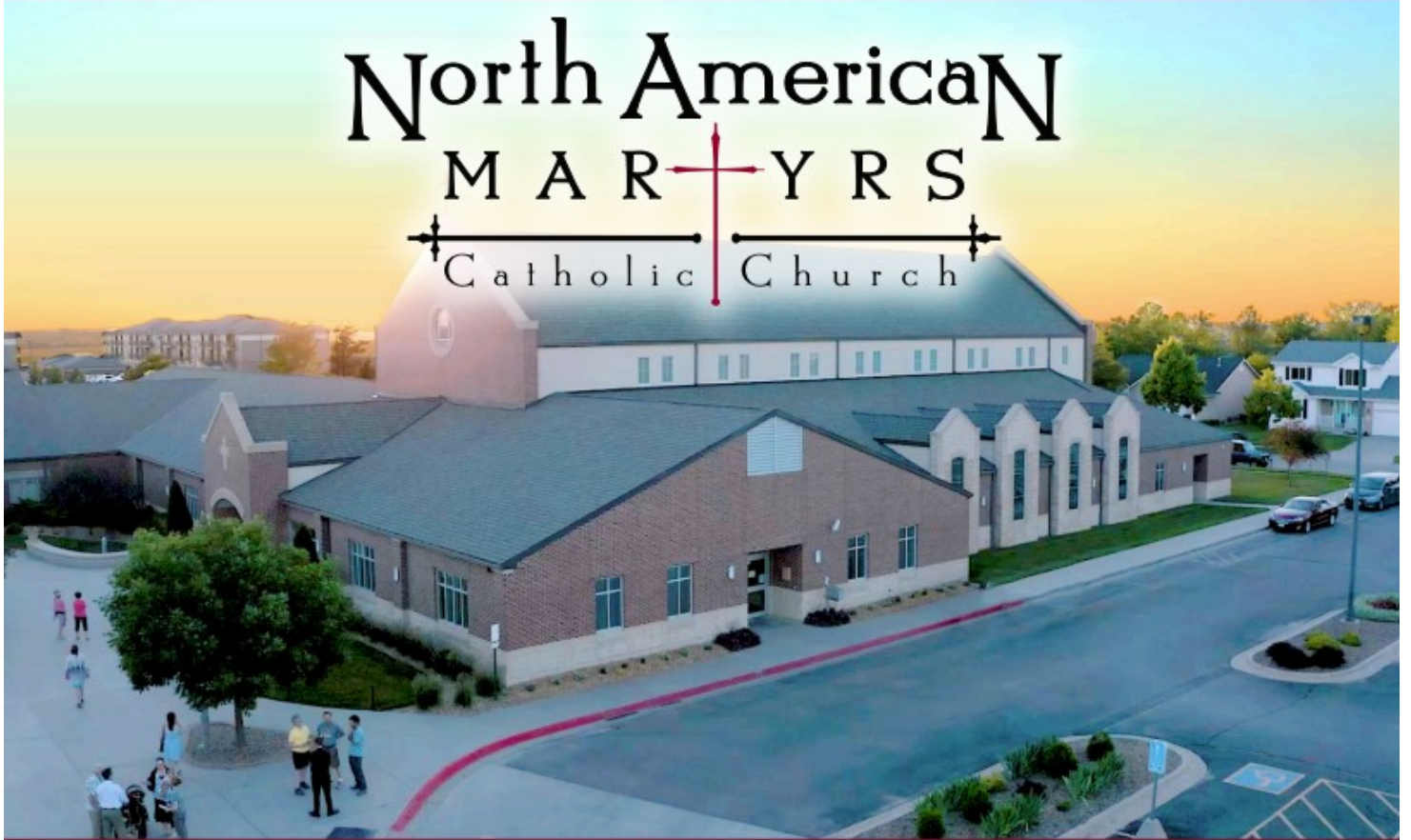

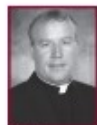

#### ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

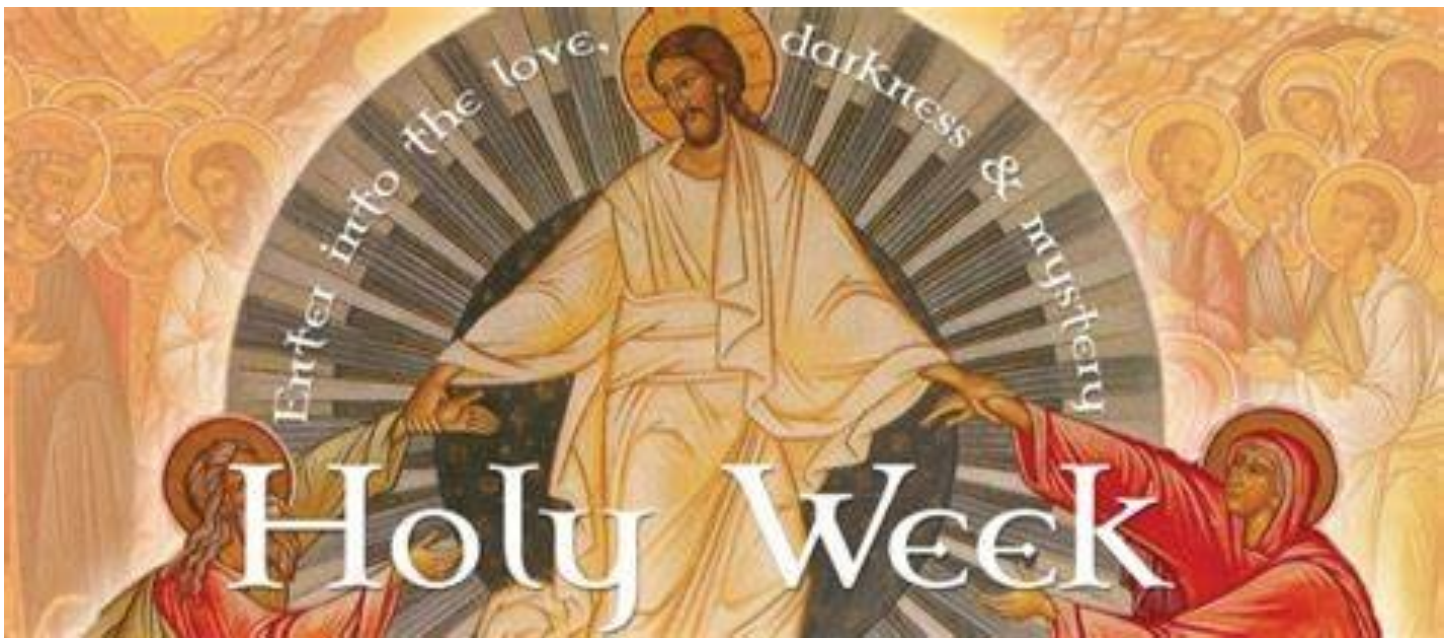
