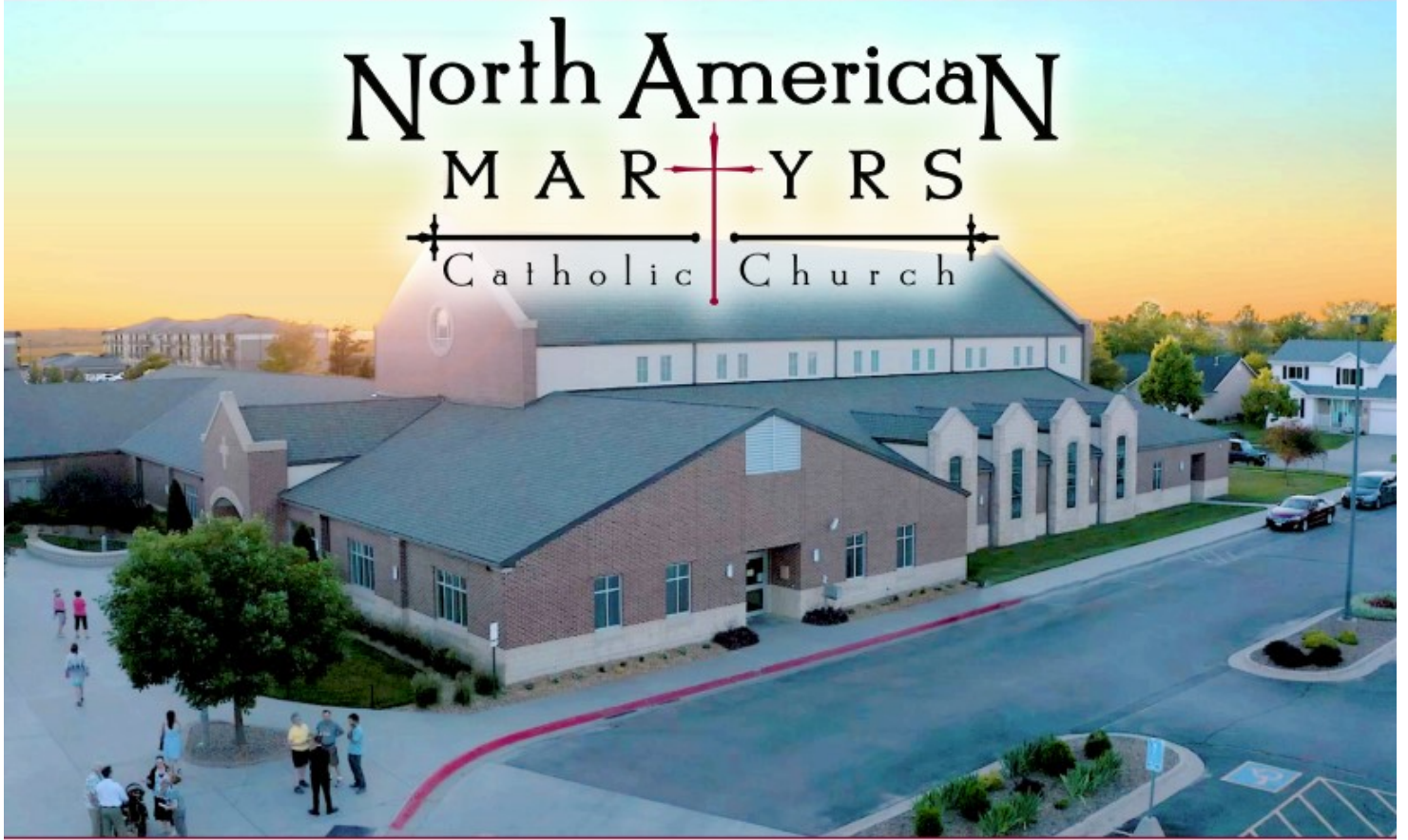

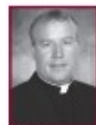

A Note from our Pastor...

The Lord is risen! Alleluia!



I want to give a little context on why we can be so joyful because Jesus rose from the dead. Before the time of Christ, people could only guess at what happens to us after we die. All people could do was cling to vague hopes that maybe if we're good then something good happens after we die ... but this was all just conjecture. Perhaps God the Father placed that feeling into the hearts of humans to prepare us for the truth, but again, no one knew for sure.

In the end, when Jesus rose from the dead and then ascended into heaven to go and prepare a place for us (ref. John 14:2), He taught us the truth about heaven. Heaven is the place of permanent, uninterrupted joy. If the totality of our lives can be summarized as "I chose God in this life," then God respects our wishes and gives us Himself for all eternity. In full disclosure, the opposite is true too. If our lives are us choosing ourselves over God, then God will respect that decision for eternity as well.

But overall, have joy! Have hope! We know that the struggles and sufferings of this world are nothing compared to the joys that await His faithful when we die (ref. Romans 8:18). Thank you Jesus for letting us know you have power over everything, and that includes death itself.

I want to thank everyone who helped this Holy Week and Easter, all of the ministers who assisted, acolytes, readers, servers, Tom Kathe for leading the charge of organizing and practices, the musicians as well! Along with all of the parish and school staff for holding things together in the administrative parts of the parish, as the priests focus more on the people and liturgies. 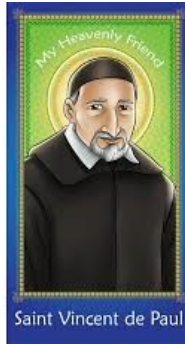

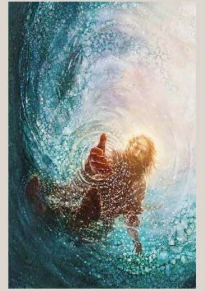
