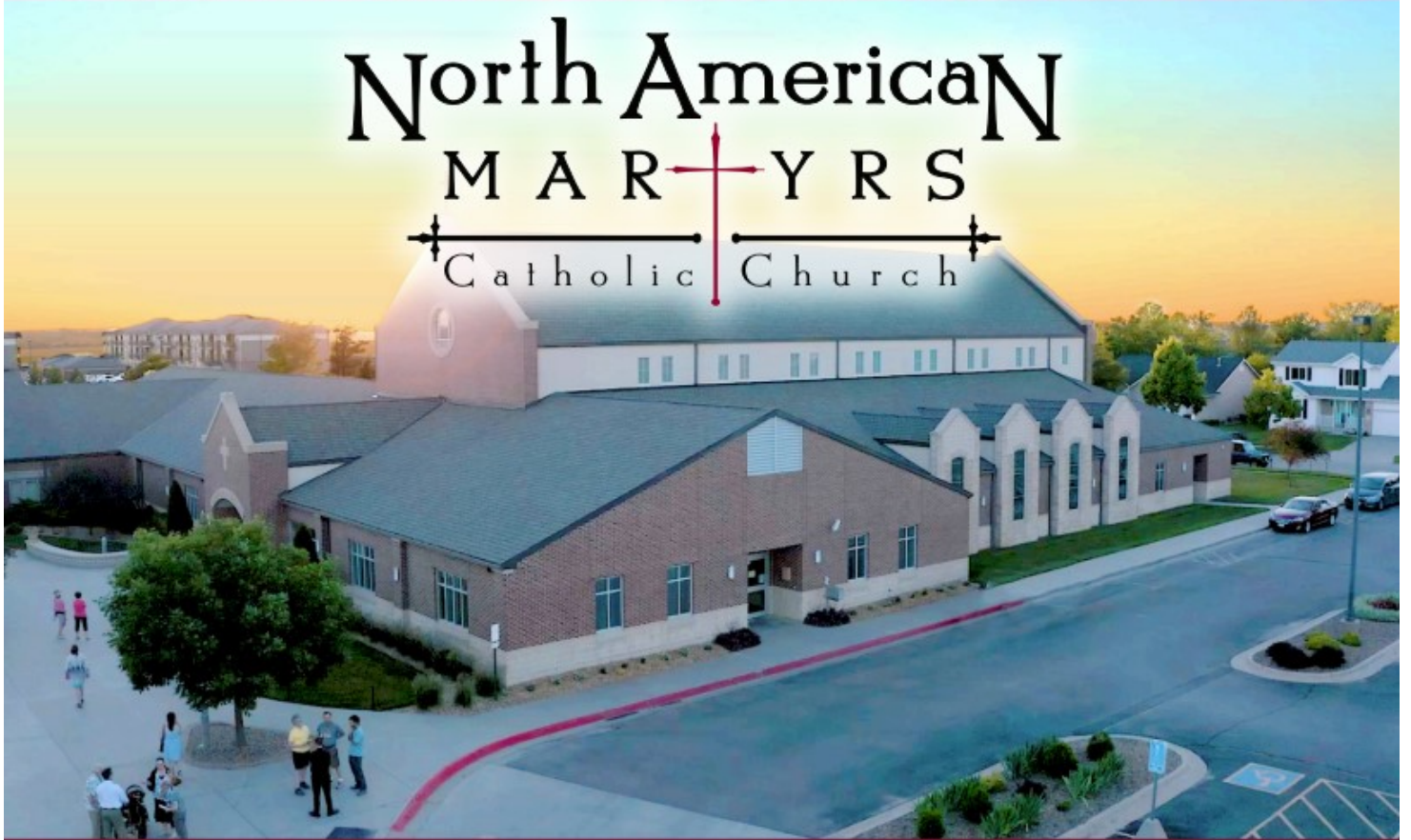

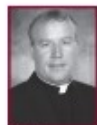

Support a new youth ministry position that will allow for greater invitation and engagement for our youth, the future of our church.

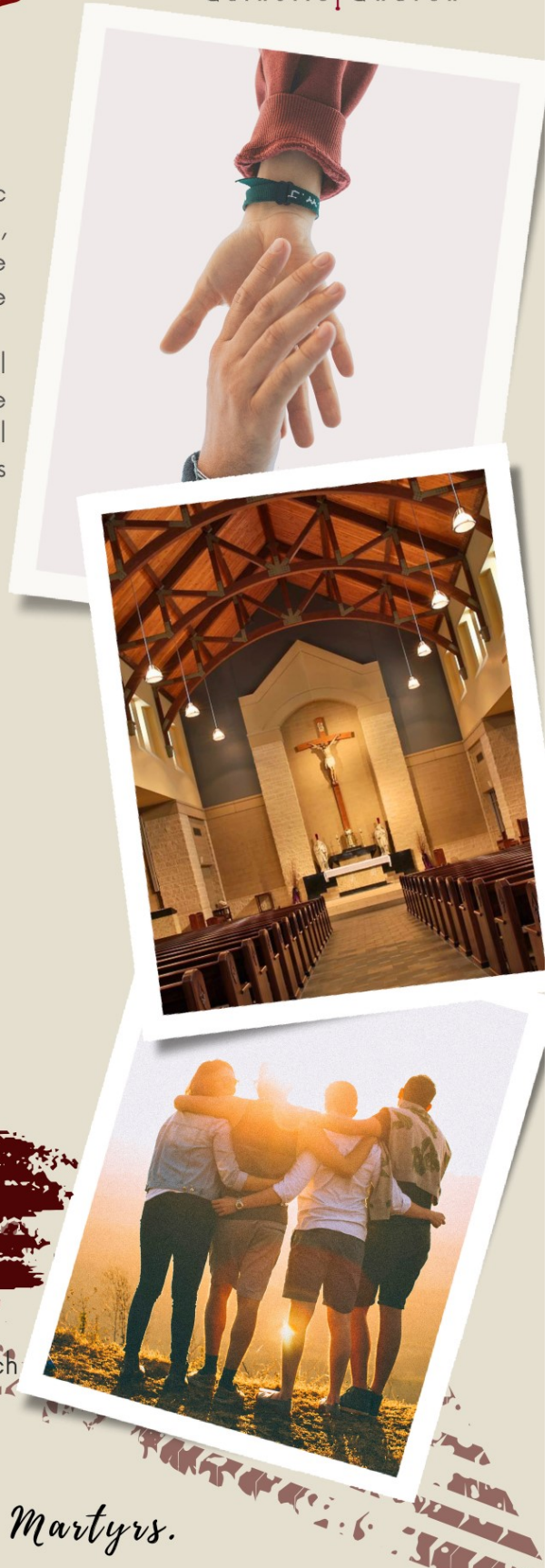

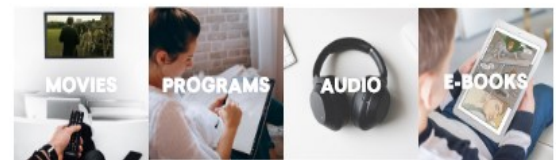
### FIRST RECONCILIATION, FIRST HOLY COMMUNION, & CONFIRMATION
