The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* (paragraph 665) says, "Christ's Ascension marks the definitive entrance of Jesus' humanity into God's heavenly domain, whence he will come again (cf. Acts 1:11); this humanity in the meantime hides him from the eyes of men (cf. Col 3:3)."In 2024, the Feast of the Ascension is on Thursday, May 9. See below for Ascension Mass times:
