A NOTE FROM OUR PASTOR...

Hello!

Each year, the Church invites us on November 2nd to pause, pray, and remember in love the souls of all who have gone before us marked with the sign of faith. All Souls' Day is a day of deep hope. It reminds us that the bonds of love do not end with death, and that our prayers truly help our loved ones on their journey toward the fullness of heaven.



The beauty of our Catholic Faith is that we are part of something much larger than ourselves — the Communion of Saints. We belong to a family that stretches across heaven, earth, and even purgatory. On All Saints' Day (November 1st) we rejoice with those who now see God face to face; on All Souls' Day, we tenderly remember those still being purified in God's mercy. Both days reveal the same truth: love endures, and in Christ, no one is ever forgotten.

As you come to Mass this weekend, I invite you to bring to prayer the names and faces of those you love who have died — parents, grandparents, friends, and especially those who may have no one to pray for them. Write their names in our parish Book of the Dead up front by the ambo, light a candle, or simply say the prayer: "Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen."

In praying for the dead, we also remind ourselves of the hope that one day, by God's mercy, we too will be gathered to our true home: heaven. May this month of November, the month of all souls, be a time of gratitude, prayer, and renewed trust in the promise of the Resurrection.

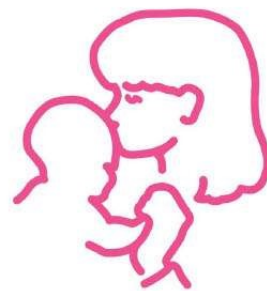
