A Note from our Pastor...

ello North American Martyrs!

As was announced at all the masses last week, we will have our parish's Book of the Dead located by the ambo for the month of November. Feel free to write the names of loved ones who have passed, so that we may pray for the repose of their soul.



Next, you may have noticed some pictures around the parish. In short, Pius X High School is doing a Capital Campaign and is partnering with all the Lincoln parishes. While we'll get more in-depth about this on December 5th and 6th, I wanted to just explain the basics. Here are some of the main points:

- 1. Pius has facilities that are decades out of date and falling apart. The school was originally designed for around 600 students, but enrollment is around 1,100. While they've done an excellent job of making due, it's time to see about improvements.
- 2. When Pius does its parish fundraising, a portion of the proceeds go directly back to our parishes.
- 3. The parish goal of fundraising will be over five years, so when we reveal more details it'll be over a five year timeline.

If we achieve our goal, the parish will receive funding back and we can achieve some much needed goals/improvements (please see the information around the church).




Our Faithfully Departed in November




