

Who are the Pink Sisters?

The Holy Spirit Adoration Sisters are cloistered nuns whose Convent and Church are located at 1040 S. Cotner Blvd. in Lincoln. Their order was founded in Holland in 1896, and in 1973 after years of effort, Bishop Flavin succeeded in bringing a group of the Sisters to Lincoln. The original community was comprised of six sisters; today there are five. The "Pink Sisters" derive their name from the rose-colored habits they wear. The Sisters devote their lives to prayer before the Eucharistic Lord, for the benefit of the Church, priests, the people of the Diocese of Lincoln, and for the entire world.

What is the Pink Sisters' Auxiliary?

The Pink Sisters Auxiliary was formed to share the Eucharistic apostolate of prayers for the Diocese of Lincoln and beyond. Members receive many spiritual blessings, such as remembrance in the Sisters' prayers before the Eucharistic Lord and in their daily Masses, in four solemn Novenas each year, and enrollment in perpetual adoration at death. The Sisters also welcome special requests or intentions that members have. Intentions may be placed in the drop box located in the vestibule of the Chapel, or a member may call or write to the Sisters directly at their residence.

How to Become a Member:

Everyone is invited to become a member of the Pink Sisters Auxiliary and are also invited to enroll others. For a membership contribution of \$10 per year for an individual or \$20 per year for a family, Auxiliary members help the Sisters with household expenses such as paying utility bills, and for Church needs.
