A NOTE FROM OUR PAROCHIAL VICAR,



Dear Martyrs Family,

Maybe you have noticed that during the holy season of Lent, even our worship of God takes on a new character. The altar is bare, there are no overt decorations. The Gloria is not sung or even said at Sunday Mass. The liturgy itself seems to be fasting in quiet prayer, waiting for God to speak.

The austerity of Mass during Lent is intentional. It is meant to reflect a solemn disposition of mind. There is a wise saying among Catholics that reads “he who knows not the fast will never know the true joy of the feast.”

Fasting is not about punishment but rather withdrawing from shallow delights in order to be awakened to deeper spiritual realities.

To reflect this, our Sunday Masses will all be reciting the Responsorial Psalm, a part of the Mass that is usually sung. You may have even noticed that we are using the solemn Latin Mass chants during the Eucharistic prayer. All of these seasonal adjustments are invitations to experience Lent in the liturgy. To be with our Lord in silence and austerity so that we may join Him in His Triumphant Victory.

Only after the fast, is the feast revealed.

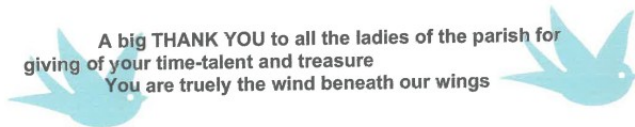
