Praise be to Almighty God, and to His Son, our High Priest, Jesus Christ, for through the grace of the Holy Spirit, we have two new priests of the Diocese of Lincoln! Fr. Peter Foley and Fr. Brad Moss were ordained by Bishop Conley on Saturday, May 23rd. Both celebrated their Masses of Thanksgiving on Pentecost Sunday.



What a fitting weekend to celebrate the gift of the priesthood, for it is through Jesus' sacrifice on the Cross and through the outpouring of the Holy Spirit that all the Sacraments are given to Jesus' beloved bride, the Church.

A message repeated throughout ordination weekend was that Jesus reveals the glory of God the Father through His priesthood. His Apostles, the first ordained priests, continue to reveal that radiant splendor through their priestly ministry.
