Hello Martyrs Parishioners!

This weekend, we'll have a short presentation from Mater Filius, a new initiative Bishop Conley is bringing to our diocese. Mater Filius Lincoln is a volunteers-based ministry dedicated to providing a safe, family-like setting for pregnant women in need and supporting them with housing, transportation, life skills, education, spiritual care, and a path to independence, all at no cost to the mothers.

This initiative, *Mater Filius* ("Mother and Child") is a thoroughly Catholic lay association of the faithful with existing homes in Omaha, Cincinnati, Colorado Springs, Milwaukee, and beyond. Mater Filius Lincoln is its own 501(c)(3) nonprofit and will begin by leasing a house from Catholic Social Services of Southern Nebraska with the hope of opening its doors this year. As this ministry continues to grow in our diocese, Mater Filius Lincoln is beginning the work of seeking support (prayer, volunteers and donations) & parish engagement. SPOTLIGHT ON OUR NEW SEMINARIAN: TOM RAJEWSKI

Hello everyone! My name is Tom Rajewski. I just completed my 2nd year of Theology and will be entering 3rd Theology this fall at Mount St. Mary Seminary in Emmitsburg, MD (10 minutes south of Gettysburg, PA or 1.5 hours north of Baltimore/DC). I just wanted to give you a reference point, since Emmitsburg is a small town.

I grew up in Lincoln and was blessed to receive a Catholic education all the way from elementary through high school graduating from Sacred Heart and Pius X. Following my time at Pius X, I attended the University of Nebraska here in Lincoln and received my degree in Secondary Education with a concentration in Social Studies. Upon completion of my degree, I taught in various Catholic schools around Lincoln for 5 years. During this time of teaching, I recognized in my heart the desire for the priesthood which had always been there since I was in 2nd or 3rd grade. I knew that this could no longer be ignored and that I needed to respond to how the Lord was inviting me to discern a priestly vocation. Since entering seminary, I have experienced a deeper friendship with Christ and continued to grow in the love which He offers all of us as His disciples.

Now after completing four years of seminary, I have two remaining until I will be ordained a priest. One of the changes that has been made in seminary education is when a man is ordained a transitional deacon. Normally a man is ordained a deacon at the end of 3rd Theology in May and is a deacon for a full year until he is ordained a priest at the end of 4th Theology. Moving forward, ordination to the diaconate will now occur in December (at the end of the fall semester of 4th Theology) instead of May. This means that a man will be a deacon for only 5 months and he will also be in a parish here in the diocese of Lincoln for those remaining months leading up to his priestly ordination. Please pray for me as I continue my studies and discernment in seminary and know that you will all be in my prayers. Thank you for welcoming me into your parish family during these summer months. I look forward to meeting and walking alongside you in your journey to Christ!
