A NOTE FROM OUR PAROCHIAL VICAR...



Hello Martyrs Parishioners!

What are these things the Church calls “Last Rites”?

Well, for starters, Jesus is truly the “Divine Physician.” St. Luke the Evangelist knows this to be true. It is the portrait of Jesus that appears in his Gospel repeatedly. St. Luke himself may have been a physician. Throughout the Gospel, Jesus heals many believers from various ailments. He is presented as the Good Samaritan who rescues the lost and pours oil and wine into their wounds, nursing us back to health. He ministers to the dying, as He Himself is dying, promising the repentant thief, “Today, you will be with Me in Paradise.”

“Last Rites” are Jesus’ ministry to the dying.

They are comprised of **three sacraments**: Confession, the Holy Eucharist, and the Anointing of the Sick. They also include a **plenary indulgence** for the remission of temporal punishment due to sin called, the Apostolic Pardon.

Confession forgives any eternal punishment due to sin, as God Himself unbinds us from our past mistakes and regrets. The Holy Eucharist is our “food for the journey to Heaven” as Jesus leads us to His Father. And Anointing is given to strengthen and heal both physical and spiritual weakness.

None of these sacraments are exclusive to those who are about to stand before God, but they are all included in the Church’s ministry for the dying.

If you or someone you love is close to death, call the priest for these Sacraments. We must prepare for death. I have seen so many incredible ways God has loved those souls who are about to see Him, face-to-face. It is an indescribable experience to walk out of a hospital room, knowing that the one within has their sins forgiven and that their Heavenly Father awaits them!

Last Rites do not have to be given right at the moment of death but are given in anticipation. They are best given when the recipient can make a good confession.

We have a special phone number to contact our Priests in case of any sacramental emergency- I encourage you, put this number in your phone.

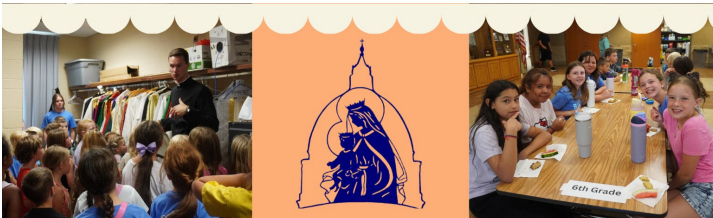
