With schools in full swing, please know of my prayers for all of you during this changing of times and season.



We've got a lot of wonderful things coming up at the parish. Reminder, feel free to invite even non-Catholic friends/neighbors/coworkers to any of our events!

1. OCIA - This is just an open, inviting way to learn about what the Catholic Church, the Church that Jesus founded 2,000 years ago, actually teaches. Begins September 9th at 6pm in the Parish Hall - Dinner is always provided!
2. CCD - Catechetical Program for grades 1st through 8th. The Church asks at every Baptism if the parents and Godparents will help raise their children in the Faith.
